

ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

1. Application for non-resident attendance will be made to the School Committee through the Superintendent, at whose discretion the student may attend school in the interim.
2. Tuition rates for non-resident students will be based on the per student cost as determined annually by the Rhode Island Department of Education. Tuition may be charged on a pro-rated basis for any portion of the year in which the student has non-residence status.
3. The School Committee will consider each application on its individual merits. The student must have a satisfactory disciplinary and academic record. Retention will be limited to the end of the school year in which the non-residence occurs.
4. Under certain circumstances, the School Committee may waive payment of tuition.
