

# Summer Math Practice

Students who just completed Kindergarten through grade 4 are being asked to complete math practice problems over the summer. Our students had a busy year learning new math skills using the Go Math! Program. Mastery of all these skills is extremely important in order to develop a solid math foundation. Each year builds upon the previous year's skills in math. The suggested math practice problems reinforce math skills learned this year and skills that will be needed for the next grade.

- Click on Start learning now.
- Sign in with Gmail or an email account.
- Create a new account.
- Once logged in, choose the subject (Math).
- Choose the grade just completed.
- Click on a topic.
- Select activities weekly.

**When school starts again in the Fall, print out a Performance Summary for all work completed.**

- Return this Summary to your new teacher during the first week of school.
- Include your name, school, grade, and parent signature on the Summary.

If you still want more practice, go to <http://www-k6.thinkcentral.com> and work on some of the practice problems you can find there to review your math skills. This is the site you have worked on all year.

- Select your state, district, and school.
- Enter your username and password. **(the same as you used all year)**
- Click Login. The student welcome page will appear. My library gives you access to the online version of the text book that you just finished, as well as any other materials the teacher has made available.

If you don't have Internet access at home, you can use the public library to access the computers and Wi-Fi.
